Trump Prophecies Part 2: The Aftermath Analysis

I want to give you an update on recent happenings this last week in the re-election battle in America and also examine some of the implications for the evangelical church of the fall-out of recent developments.

This last week some recent developments I wish to analyze....

Firstly, my brother sent me an article from America that appeared in the well known Newsweek magazine. I will paste the opening portion for reference on comments I need to make:

Minister Prophecies Trump Comeback, Says 'God Hates' Biden Support of Equality Act, Abortion Rights

Christian "prophets" and ministers across the U.S. are following up on their nearly unanimous prophecies proclaiming President [Donald Trump](#) would "without question" win re-election. But with [Joe Biden](#) now named President-elect, church leaders are either apologizing or doubling down and predicting a Trump comeback led by the Supreme Court and Baby Boomers.

Several evangelical and Christian church leaders, including televangelist Pat Robertson, White House spiritual adviser Paula White and First Baptist Church Pastor Robert Jeffress, all made bold predictions about a sweeping Trump victory in the presidential election. Those hopes were dashed Saturday as nearly every major news outlet declared Biden the winner, prompting a scrambled effort among many so-called "prophets" to explain their glaring error in interpreting God

This article is typical of a wave of public attacks in the media on the prophetic movement in America, all mocking evangelicals as gullible and ignorant. I will comment in a moment but two more things that struck me this week....

Secondly, I watched a live presentation by the respected legal eagle Sydney Powell who is the attorney for Gen Flynn and Rudi Giuliani do press briefing on their findings over the last weeks of massive fraud and vote manipulation of the election result in 10 states. Apparently the voting machines used and the software they work

on was hacked with backdoor access to manipulation of results. They plan to bring their evidence to the courts and ask for the nullification of the results of those states to deny Biden the 270 Electoral College votes he needs on 14 December to be officially declared the new president. With neither candidate having 270 votes the election of the president would be done by the house of representatives of each of the 50 states with each state having 1 vote. Under this election since the republicans control more state houses than democrats, Donald Trump would be re-elected president.

Thirdly, a few nights ago I watched a short 5 minute Youtube broadcast from one of my favourite prophetic voices in America, a man of integrity and 50 years service in the Lord with proven prophetic track record making this bold declaration...."don't give up, stand firm, the angel of the Lord stood by me this night to say the battle is the Lord's, etc"

My reactions....

Across the world there is a mocking of the evangelical movement and it really makes me angry. Not just in America. There is a type of persecution now of Christians as fools and naive and it makes me really angry. My heart goes out to God's people who want to see righteousness in their nations, want to see justice done, who recognize there are evil forces entrenched in their government, who see their national cultures decaying into barbarism...these people of God want a champion that will "drain the swamp", will restore justice, will turn the tide of moral, cultural and economic disintegration.

The prophetic leadership of the American evangelical church has said Donald Trump is God's anointed man to do this job. If it is obvious that he has not accomplished this in his first term in office then it is because he needs to have a second term to finish the job and God will give it to him.

Now let me acknowledge my prejudice here. I really, really, really want this guy to get a second term and do all these things that need to be done in America. I grew up in America. I am not an American but I think it is a great nation that deserves great leaders to restore the moral and economic foundations of that nation.

I also really want the mouths of mockers to be silenced by a miraculous re-election of Trump that will not only bless the nation and give hope for a moral regeneration of the nation but will elevate the office of prophets in the church and give witness to the world that will astound the mockers.

That is what I hope for. But again my honest appraisal? I don't think it is going to happen. By Tuesday next week most or all of the states votes will be completed and certified by their officials and these will go to the Electoral College of the vote on 14 December. From what I have seen of the legal case that Trump attorneys want to bring, I believe there is probable cause for a deeper investigation of the software and hardware of the voting machines, but I think it is too late and not enough for the courts to overturn the whole election.

So.... on the reasonable assumption the election as now declared stands, what are the further implications for the church as we move forward?

Last week I made an analysis of why and how the prophetic can get it wrong. I don't want to go there again. I want to move from the crisis in the prophetic movement to the crisis in the leadership of the church.

The leadership of the church (here I am referring to the evangelical and charismatic expression of the church) is responsible for answering the question for the people of "where is God leading us at this time and how do we proceed to God's plans for His church at this time?" I am responsible in my own life for answering those questions of what is God's plan for my life and how do I get there. If I make a mistake on that it is my responsibility and not the church leadership. Jesus said my sheep hear my voice....I am responsible to hear His voice for my life and my family.

Now I want to apply that insight to the leadership crisis we face. I can make mistakes along my life journey as to which job, which house, wrong timing, etc by missing God's plan. I can still recover and make a zig zag and get on track and finish my life the way the Lord wanted.

The same for the church. Leaders can make a mistake and recover and get back on track. We all make mistakes. But over a 40 year period there are things that are beyond dispute that are not just temporary mistakes but strategic errors that lead the church into dead ends that eventually show themselves to be not of the Lord and unfruitful and unprofitable for the people of God regardless if it is of benefit to the leadership. That to me is the issue we are facing today.

My problem with the prophetic and apostolic is not that we have necessarily false prophets or false apostles. I honor these offices and persons for the countless times that they have made accurate prophecies into the lives of God's people that have blessed and edified and built up the faith of God's people.

Here is our problem. Scripture says "we know in part and we prophesy in part". I make this analysis. God is taking His church in such a radical new direction that what lies ahead is nowhere in their understanding of what the "end times" mean. Their frame of reference is bound by old visions of old theology for a previous generation.

There is a critical difference between a Moses prophetic leadership needed for navigating the wilderness of Sinai that needs miracle of guidance, healing, provisions, water etc and the leadership of an Apostolic Joshua that is going to take new territory for the Kingdom of God.

After 40 years looking back on the journey of the church our present church leadership is stuck into old patterns of old theology. The question is if the leadership got Donald Trump wrong then what else have they got wrong? Let me identify dead ends that are outdated for the new era ahead and that need new vision and new leadership

1) If we bless Israel....

One of the things that need to be obviously reassessed but which the current church leadership will never do is this idea of "whoever blesses Israel God will bless". Nobody has ever blessed the nation of Israel as has America and Donald Trump.

What has been America's reward and Donald Trump's reward for blessing Israel? Be honest. As America heads into a Great Depression 2.0 and Trump heads for electoral defeat exactly what happened to their blessing?

The issue for new leadership: Get the church out of Dual Covenantalism and get serious about discipling the Jewish people into the Kingdom of God and not into a restored Jewish Kingdom. Get out of blessing by race theology and get back to salvation by grace theology, with no exception for Jews. There is no blessing apart from the New Covenant in Christ and faith in His finished work. Therefore there is no blessing from God for blessing those who reject Christ

2) What happened to 40 years of "prosperity preaching"?

This is so obviously a financial dead end by the pure fact that by all statistical measurements the broad American middle class which is the bulk of the evangelicals are today far poorer per family and per capita than they were 40 years ago regardless of "tithing or seed faith giving". The fact of the matter is that there is no book or prosperity sermon I have read or heard in 40 years that even begins to address the economic principles of Mosaic law economics. Neither is there any book or sermons I have heard on Jubilee economics which will lead to the realization of Jesus prophetic declaration that the meek will inherit the earth. A Trump second term will only mean his banker and finance pals continue to inherit the earth.

The issue for new leadership: Get off the economic titanic that is the world debt based finance system and get God's people into and onto a new kingdom platform of endless economic growth and prosperity applying God's Mosaic Jubilee economic system. And by the way, local pastors are not qualified to teach these principles and it cannot be done in stirring 40 minute sermons of miracle money exhortations.

3) Discipleship Dynamics

The current model of mass meetings and one man leadership that presents Sunday sermons 50 times a year is not producing disciples or labourers qualified to work in the kingdom. Which is why Jesus said "the labourers are few". Is there perhaps a message from God in the present Corona virus pestilence that is blocking church gatherings and forcing Christians back into home church meetings? It is time to re-assess the effectiveness of church as expressed in mass meetings.

The issue for new leadership: It is time to get back to the New Testament model of the Church. Meaning people meeting in homes where there is true discipleship taking place, needs are being realized and answered, ministries are being developed. All these home groups need to be gathered into a large "City Church" expression whereby all God's people in a region can participate in impacting their city for the Kingdom of God and all God's people are exposed to multiple ministries to impact their lives, where there are plurality of elders and leaders caring for the direction and ministry to the people to avoid the mistakes of one man leadership.

4) The 7 mountain influence the world strategy

There is a time when God sends His people into Babylon and Egypt and says, Be my witnesses and influence the nation. Then there is time God says it is time to exit Egypt and Babylon and get on with building my house, my New Jerusalem. Ask yourself this: To what extent are we influencing the world and to what extent is the

world influencing our people? Look at all the Charismatics and evangelicals in Washington in Congress and the White House. Has this made a meaningful difference in policy and Christian values? Think of specific churches who become "seeker friendly" like Hillsong in New York which has reached out to all sorts of celebrities and A-listers. And now we have scandal there of gross sexual impropriety by church leadership with pictures of leadership on private jets, yachts, parties etc. Or the scandals at Liberty University or the many financial scandals of charismatic leaders living in luxurious mansions with incomes in the millions.

The issue for new leadership: It is time to get out of Babylon world system, not in the rapture or some far desert community. The Lord has given us the technology for local community independence. New energy sources, new communications systems, new own currency systems, new ways to teach our children, new manufacturing systems for local economic development. But most of all He has given us a new generation of young entrepreneurs that want to take the land for the Kingdom of God and are not intimidated by the giants of industry or the walled cities of mega-finance but will do kingdom start ups to build the Mountain of the Lord that will be a witness to the nations.

We do not go to their seven mountains to influence them. We go to their seven mountains and take what we need for the Kingdom of God and relocate those riches of the earth for the Kingdom of God back to the Mountain of the Lord.....and they come to us and say teach us your ways.

No Donald Trump is not our leader. He is not our champion to drain the swamp. Let the swamp creatures devour each other. Let us be about building God's Kingdom and on His rock.

The current prophetic and apostolic leadership do not see these dead ends. So they prophecy according to their faith be it unto them. And yes I really do hope and pray Donald Trump gets re-elected. But if he doesn't we the church will carry on with the Kingdom agenda that inevitably leads to nations being discipled into the Kingdom of God, swamps getting drained, swamp creatures getting saved.

There is going to be an inevitable loss of confidence by Christians in leaders that they feel are not hearing from God. I see the inevitability of new leadership and new vision so has it been over 2000 years of Church history whenever God is ready to do a new thing.
