Babylon Falling: The Athenian Democracy Experiment Fails Again

The three pillars of the modern era Western Civilization are crumbling. Democracy, Finance Capitalism and the military might to back them up. As a secular religion they need the faith of the believers.....and that is crumbling as well.

I saw an article this week about a new appointment at Harvard University that is apropos to my thesis.....

The New Chief Chaplain at Harvard? An Atheist.

To quote....

The Puritan colonists who settled in New England in the 1630s had a nagging concern about the churches they were building: How would they ensure that the clergymen would be literate? Their answer was Harvard University, a school that was established to educate the ministry and adopted the motto "Truth for Christ and the Church." It was named after a pastor, John Harvard, and it would be more than 70 years before the school had a president who was not a clergyman. Nearly four centuries later, Harvard's organization of chaplains has elected as its next president an atheist named Greg Epstein, who takes on the job this week. Mr. Epstein, 44, author of the book "Good Without God," is a seemingly unusual choice for the role.

To get a better comprehension of my analysis of the significance of what is now happening in both America and the West with regard to the shift in geopolitics it would help if you read my article on the website titled "The Significance of America and 9-11"

I am not surprised that Harvard University the bastion of academic excellence in America and the world, appointed an atheist as campus chaplain. I am surprised that it took them so long. And Harvard and its Ivy League clones have been hard at it for several centuries to create a good civilization without God.

The idea that mankind can be good without God is an evolving program since the enlightenment era of the 17th and 18th centuries. Not only is man inherently good but man can create also a good civilization without God. The template for this humanist tower of Babel comes from the Athenian state and the supposedly golden age of Pericles and the Athenian democracy (490 BC-429 BC)

I mentioned to you previously that when the Greek philosophers of Ionia came up with the idea of "The Logos" as an underlying law of how reality functions apart from

appealing to warring gods of Olympus, they decided such a monumental discovery needed a people and a city that will be organized according to the laws of Logos. Athens decided to be that city. And so they created the concept of the "polis" (the city) and the "ekklesia" (the people who run the city) and the "Logos" (the laws that govern life and relations).

This all happened at exactly the same time that Ezekiel was teaching the Law of the Lord to the new Jewish settlers who had come out of Babylon and Nehemiah was rebuilding the city and walls of Jerusalem. And while the Jews were rebuilding the Temple in Jerusalem, Pericles was doing a massive embezzlement of the savings funds of the Delian League (Athens "NATO" partners) to build the great Acropolis temples.

If you read my article on the website you will note that I said that the great 1776 project of "We the people of the United States"....was in actual fact a Masonic project to create a humanist experiment in Athenian democracy in opposition to the great Puritan project of America as God's "City on a Hill", the nation that embodies the light of the gospel to the world.

So yes the infiltration of the great Puritan vision of Harvard and Princeton as places to teach the laws of God and then turned into secular temples of humanism was part of the entire takeover of the American state by the Masonic humanists.

For Masons symbols are very important. They love their secret signs and signals and ceremonies. The twin towers of New York and the pentagram of the Washington Pentagon as well as the Egyptian obelisk of the Washington monument and the dome of the Capitol building are all critical in Masonic lore.

In Masonic lore there is no greater person than Hiram Abiff "the Widow's son" the great builder and architect of Solomon's temple. When Solomon wanted to build the great temple in Jerusalem he the king Hiram of Tyre for workmen and materials. The chief architect of the Temple was Hiram Abiff who designed the Temple using designs of the Baal temples with their twin towers. (1 Kings 5:5-6)

This was great for Solomon. He had a vision of making Jerusalem rich and prosperous through international trade which needed international alliances and good relations with all nations. To achieve these foreign policy goals for his trade policy he married hundreds of foreign wives and built temples in Jerusalem for all the nations gods. That was Solomon, a wonderful globalist. And an apostate.

Can you see why Hiram Abiff and Solomon are the heroes of the Masons who designed Washington DC, wrote the Declaration of Independence and the US Constitution. And modeled America on the great humanist experiment of Athenian democracy and cultural imperialism combined with military strength. The Enlightenment provided a new "Logos" of how the universe worked and the industrial revolution provided the means to exploit the wealth of nature...without reference to the God of creation. This new Logos of reality required a new "polis" (Washington DC) and a new "ekklesia" (We the people...) and a new Logos (the Constitution)

The great democratic experiment of Athens only lasted probably 60 years as the "ekklesia" of Athens decided what American secretary of state Madeleine Albright voiced "What is the use of a military if you don't use it". So they let loose with their famous naval forces and basically pillaged the Mediterranean with popular victorious generals celebrated for bringing glory and loot to Athens. And military disasters (the Egyptian campaign and others). And the Ekklesia heartily voted for these wars!

Any of this sounding familiar?

But there is a basic problem with the idea of "We the people in order to form a more perfect union...." This sort of government requires the faith of the people. In fact the whole of modern democratic free enterprise capitalism is a "faith enterprise". And the required military to back it up is a "fear enterprise". Let me explain....

The modern democratic state realizes that not every governing decision can be made by the people. Therefore the idea of "representative democracy". We elect people who will vote on our behalf on all the many decisions that need to be made. That requires that people must have faith in the system and their representatives.

The same in the economic system. That is the second great pillar of the twin towers. People need faith in the democratic economic system. They need faith that their savings entrusted to the banks will be safe and their money will buy tomorrow what it can buy today...that it is a safe store of value.

They need to trust the free market system that there are honest prices for goods and labour that reflect true value based on supply and demand.

They need to trust the financial institutions who they depend on for old age retirement will make sound investments of their savings, preserve their precious capital and give them an honest return on their capital.

All of these critical foundations to modern civilization are based on faith and trust...."I believe"; "I trust". I believe and trust in my government, in my political representatives, they are voting for my best interests. I believe and trust the financial system that my money is sound, that my investments are safe, that I have a future for myself and my family. I trust that when I pay my taxes the police and justice system will protect me. I believe when I send my children to school and college they will be taught skills that will enable them to be usefully employed.

These are foundational faith creeds much like faith creeds of a religion. It is these faith declarations that bind a people together as the citizens of a nation. They are the glue that keeps society functioning. If these foundations crumble...the nation state falls.

The proposition of the humanist tower of Babel is that we humans can "keep the faith" apart from God. Intrinsic to both the economic system and the political system are promises made and promises kept. The entirety of the functioning economic model is "I promise to pay". The entirety of the functioning of the political model is "I promise to provide."

Is this working? I take as my prophetic timeline of the course of divine history the dream of Nebuchadnezzar that Daniel interpreted for him. A very simple vision and explanation. Successive human world empires. Until there came a rock cut from the mountain. This rock, the Kingdom of God would smash the kingdoms of the world and would then grow and grow to fill the earth. But the last international rule would be characterized by a mixture of iron and clay. It looks strong like iron...but cannot hold together and will crumble like clay.

Now look at the near past of the nations of the West. The controllers of world commerce, the models for a new world order. Do you see the media and news reports. Does it seem to you that the people have either faith in the political system and the political rulers of the system? Are the people losing faith in the promises of the economic system? Do the political representatives truly present the interests of the people or are they bought out by special interests? Do the banking and financial powers still enjoy the trust of the people that the economic system is working to the benefit of all?

Is the American military still able to protect the world trading system and project power all over the world to ensure the world status of the American dollar is the premier world reserve currency? Does the world still fear the American military might....after the entire 20 year Middle East debacle? (and Vietnam?)

To me the prophetic significance of the twin towers falling and the Pentagon pierced 20 years ago were signs of the times. The history of the world of the last 20 years and the happenings of the last year with world pandemic and the debacle recently in Afghanistan...these are all signs to me. The iron and clay is crumbling the rock has struck and the world system and the faith in that system is crumbling.

It is of interest to me that the final blow that brought the Athenian democratic experiment to its knees and broke the city and the power of Athens was the great plague of 429 BC. Pericles died in that plague as did his two sons as did so many of Athens population. The Spartans soon won the war after that.

Which made the headlines of this week on the Covid-19 pandemic this week more urgent to the world economy and the world power structures.

*Anecdotes tell us what the data can't: **Vaccinated people appear to be getting the coronavirus at a surprisingly high rate.** But exactly how often isn't clear, nor is it certain how likely they are to spread the virus to others.*

And the same day as the BBG headline, there was this from UK government-funded BBC... "*Is catching Covid now better than more vaccine?*"

And from Afghanistan:

It appears that the American military in their haste to get out of Afghanistan and not waiting to first get all Americans out have left \$85 billion in military hardware for the Taliban to upgrade their old fashioned WW2 weaponry to modern weapons and to sell billions of great military equipment to other Jihadi groups. I remember George Bush justifying the Iraq invasion with "we fight them there so we don't have to fight them here". Sounded logical. Except now America has weaponized the whole radical factions of Islam and then opened its southern border to anybody by the millions....how soon before "we now have to fight them here because we lost there"?

And then from the economic news this last week, the US congress just passed a \$3,5 trillion spending bill on top of the previous month's \$1 trillion while 61% of Americans did not pay taxes last year.
