## It's Time To Ignite the Fire Prophecies Over South Africa

The evangelical Charismatic movement here in South Africa needs to distance itself from the prophetic confusion coming out of America. It is time we have our own prophetic vision from the Lord of His plans and purposes for South Africa. Here some ideas for your prayerful consideration....

I don't want to belabor the whole Trump prophetic debacle. I want to raise a higher issue for your consideration: Let's get the "Fire Prophecies" over South Africa ignited!

I am very concerned about the overwhelming influence of the American prophetic and apostolic movement on our movement here in South Africa. My interactions with charismatic leaders here and with individuals are that everyone seems to believe the American prophets regarding the Trump prophecies and the whole "end time" agenda of the American charismatic movement.

I keep asking around "but what about South Africa?". Where are our prophets? What is the Word of the Lord for us? Everyone here seems to have been to America for a preaching tour, and how many after making contacts there suddenly get a "calling" to start a church in America? As if the Lord had a shortage of preachers in America (or Australia or New Zealand).

The prophetic vision for our times coming out of America is a dead end. The recent prophetic debacle in the American charismatic movement should be a wake-up call for us here in South Africa. This prophetic debacle of 2020 was two-fold. Not only did none of the recognized prophets (those with large media presences who could get a prophetic message out) that 2020 would be a year of economic devastation and international pestilence and pandemics, but that which was prophesied (Donald Trump would be re-elected...thus says the Lord) never came to pass.

But let's move on from that. As I said I am concerned about a larger strategic direction of the prophetic movement leading the church and influencing all the charismatic churches around the world. What does the future hold? What is the next move of God?

I can sum it up as follows from all the ministries I monitor via internet, Youtube, books etc. "The Great Awakening", "The billion soul harvest", "the Latter Rain outpouring". All these indicating a great world wide revival coming....and then? The rapture. And then? The Great Tribulation, Antichrist, One World Government, Israel rebuilds the Temple, Antichrist makes pact with the Jews, Armageddon, 2/3ds of Jews

in Israel slaughtered, 144,000 Jews preach the gospel of the Kingdom and Jesus returns to restore a Jewish kingdom with Him ruling from Jerusalem.

This "end time" vision was false prophecy 40 years ago when I preached it and it will be false prophecy 40 years from now when the next generation is struggling to survive a collapsed Babylon world order. I will not belabor this false prophetic vision of the future coming out of the failed prophetic movement in America...read my articles on my website if you want to study this issue further.

The issue that needs to be confronted by the church here in South Africa is what are God's prophetic calls for our time and our nation?

So let me give you my vision as to how I look at our time and church prophetically:

If you look at the book of Revelation and the seven churches of Asia that Jesus addresses you will see that each church region of Asia had a church, each had its unique problems, each had a calling for their region, each had to have a separate prophetic word from God.

If you look all over the world you will see powerful church movements in strategic places of the world. Brazil, Central America, Britain, Singapore, Korea, China, Australia/New Zealand, Russia, Nigeria, East Africa.....Southern Africa. In each place God is raising up the battle ensigns of the Kingdom. In each place the "Mountain of the Lord" will rise. Each place has a unique gifting of people and resources. Each place is responsible for discipling their region into the Kingdom until the Kingdom of God spreads to fill the earth.

My prophetic perspective here is this:

The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof. The earth has been given to mankind to subdue and make fruitful and multiply. God expects as owner of the earth and all the people He has created, He is expecting a harvest, a return on His investment. Each great church region of the earth is responsible to the Lord God to give account to Him of what was entrusted to them.

What is God's unique calling and gifting to the church in Southern Africa? What are the resources and the people He has given us? This question brings me back to the wonderful "Fire Prophecies" that have gone out over South Africa for the last 100 years. I referred you to these in my book (Southern Africa's Prophetic Destiny which you can read online) on page 12 and by going to [www.stafp.com](http://www.stafp.com) and [www.recordingroom.co.za](http://www.recordingroom.co.za). Just a wonderful work done by Andre Baard and his group to document these prophecies.

What I wanted to know is this: I believe there is a great "Fire" of revival going to sweep across from the Southern tip of Africa....but then what? So I went through Dr. Rose's book to see what his interpretation of the "then what" would be.

Here is quote from the last portion of his book:

***I am making a statement of faith that I believe we will see the fruition of God's visitation in power during our lifetime. Immediately thereafter the rapture of the Church will occur (1 Thess. 4:13- 18; 1 Cor. 15:51-52)..... But once the harvest is completed I believe the Church, the Bride of Christ, will be snatched away (1 Thess. 4:17) "in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, . . ." (1 Cor. 15:51-52), and united with the Bridegroom, Jesus Christ. With the Church removed, the onset of the Great Tribulation will begin upon the earth.***

This is just the same prophetic perspective as the American "end times" idea. Not unusual as Dr. Rose left South Africa to live in America.

He does however raise an important question: He asks as do others, When will this "Fire Prophecy" happen? What will it look like? He mentions the great moves of God already in our nation and the great revival work done by people like Angus Buchan and the "Mighty Men" gatherings; the great revivals of Reinhardt Bonke; the great prayer gatherings organized by Graham Power and so forth. He mentions the many people who years ago moved to Cape Town expecting to be part of the beginnings of this great expected move of God.

In America it is the same. There is this prophetic expectation of a last great revival, stadiums packed with people, demonstrations of the power of God and then praise God the last end-time harvest is done and the rapture comes to take us out of here so that the Antichrist can come and take over the world and we are safe in heaven.

Folks this is not the "Fire Prophecy" I see coming. Yes there is going to be a great soul winning, stadium filling, praise and power movement coming....

My vision difference is this. The coming outpouring of power is not just the salvation of souls. That is just the beginning. You need to look at the "Fire Prophecies" of scripture to get the real picture of what is coming. You need to get to the start of the fire...where does the fire start? It does not start in Cape Town!

Here is your scripture reading assignment...go to Daniel chapter 7 and find the fire. The fire streams from the throne of God! Now read what happens when that fire starts flowing from the throne, read the chapter.....the results are nations and empires crumble, the Kingdom and the glory is handed over to "the Son of Man" and most importantly...."the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom".

Now follow that stream of fire to the Day of Pentecost. John prophesied of Jesus when He saw Him coming....behold the lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world...I baptize you with water but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

The fire prophecies over South Africa is the baptism of fire on God's people. It is Jesus channeling the fire of power from the throne of God, through Him into us to fulfil the prophecies of Daniel 7.

But here is the very important question that needs to be answered.....what is the manifestation of that fire power? How do we recognize it? I see in America their favoured idea of a great manifestation of power is a great mass crowd of people and in the front is God's man of power for the hour and he is waving his coat over the people and people all around are falling and praising etc.

But what is the manifestation of the fire power that Jesus Himself said He is looking for? Now here is my take and it is what Jesus said He wants done with His power in both Matthew 25 and when He spoke in Isaiah 58 as Yahweh to Isaiah. So here is your next reading assignment. Isaiah 58 and Matthew 25.

This is what you will read in Matthew that Jesus said will characterize the great move of God....when I was naked you clothed me, when I was hungry you fed me.....

This is what Jesus told Isaiah and the religious leaders of that day....

You people have these great public religious fasts to show your piety. That is not what I want from you. This is the fast I have chosen...

"to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burden, to let the oppressed go free, to deal your bread with the hungry, to clothe the naked, to place a roof over the homeless.....then shall your light break forth as the morning,...and the glory of the Lord shall be your reward" Isaiah 58:5-12.

"You shall receive power after the Holy Spirit is come upon you"...this is the vision of the world wide charismatic movement. But what is the purpose of that power? How is that power to be manifested...when the fire falls what is the manifestation? Up to now it has been people falling over "slain in the Spirit" or salvation crusades or prophecy or gifts of the Spirit.

But here is my "Fire over Southern Africa" prophecy interpretation. If you want to know, When will the fire fall" When will the flame be lit that will change the world? The answer is when will we tackle the work for which power is needed? You need the power of the fire of the Holy Spirit when the task is greater than what you in human strength can do. Power is for work. Power is not for display purposes.

When the church in Southern Africa gets off the "end times" dead end false prophecies coming out of the American church and gets onto God's Kingdom agenda for Southern Africa, that is when the "Fire Prophecies" will be fulfilled.

That agenda was laid out by Jesus in Matthew 25 and Isaiah 58 and Daniel 7....the time is now for the saints of the most high to possess the kingdom. The manifestation of that glory and power is when we tackle the issues of not just saving of souls but feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, housing the homeless, delivering the oppressed, healing the sick, education the children in the ways of the Lord.

To do this great task He has given us the baptism of the Holy Spirit and fire and He has given us 14 million unemployed people who need jobs and He has given us all of Southern Africa, the richest agricultural region of the world capable of not only

feeding all our people but also the multitudes of the nations who will be starving in the coming earth famines, and He has given us an abundance of rich minerals and energy resources and oceans filled with fish and technology to help get the job done and above all He has given us churches full of people who actually know how to do what needs to be done.

All we need now are prophetic and apostolic leaders who will see the real end times of the collapsing world system and the rise of the Kingdom of God to fill the earth. A church leadership who is not pandering to our fleshly desires of passivity and wanting to get out of here to avoid the coming tough times....but a leadership who will encourage and mobilize the people of God to do the work of the Kingdom.

When this vision of victory becomes the prophetic voice of our nation then the fire will start from Cape to Cairo.
