Kingdom Report

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About that Oval Office White House Meeting

I want to analyze the important meeting between Trump and Ramaphosa from its economic and international impact but most of all the signs of the times for judgment over South Africa.

The recent spectacle in the White House Oval Office between Pres. Trump and Ramaphosa only confirmed to me the need for a strategic emphasis shift in the church away from "end times" escape of the church to "end times for the nations" and the ministry of healing of the nations.

The encounter in the Oval Office was pure spectacle for the political supporters of the two presidents. Nothing was accomplished for either the people or economies of either America or South Africa.

Ramaphosa returned to SA as the hero who "stood up to Trump bullying". The South African people and economy got nothing of substance. But he proudly gave Trump a lesson on "misinformation" on white "genocide". All out of proportion. Why? Because all South Africans live in fear in a country where crime, murders, kidnappings, rape, theft are out of control and statistically is one of the top 10 dangerous nations in the world. That was the defense. And whites who leave for a safer space are cowards.

Trump in his "ambush" played the Malema mass rally with a hundred thousand in a packed stadium singing and dancing to "Kill the farmer, kill the Boer". With Ramaphosa and entourage smiling as if "oh that is old news, don't worry".

I can say this with certainty it was not old news to all political and ideological persuasions in either America or Europe. People were shocked. To give you an idea how seriously a typical EUI country like Britain feel about "incorrect speech" here a recent example......

In October of 2024, Lucy Connolly, a 42-year-old mother, was sentenced to 31 months in prison for posting "hate speech" on social media. Just this week, her appeal was denied. Connolly was responding hours after the Somali teenager with a long knife stabbed three little girls to death in their dance class.

She posted this: "I'm absolutely fing done. If we don't act now our country is finished. Mass deportation immediately, set fire to all the fing hotels full of the b^{******} for all I care, if that makes me racist so be it."

She was simply expressing what everyone horrified by the wanton slaughter felt inside. That is the level of sensitivity overseas to "hate speech".

The other important impact from the Oval Office encounter was Elon Musk and Starlink. The message got out. Musk will not invest in SA because he is not prepared to give up 30% of his investment to "black empowerment". International investors took note. They also took note of "expropriation without compensation."

Now let me give you a quick economic lesson on what is needed in South Africa's economy and why therefore this Oval Office encounter was an economic disaster for South Africa. And why this has prophetic implications.

We have 32%-40% unemployment and among young people 60%. Our peer group of emerging economies in the world average about 5%.

If we want to lower 32% unemployment to 10% unemployment it will take growth of 4% per year for 20 years. We are presently growing at maybe 1% while our population is growing at 2%. Meaning we are getting poorer as a nation every year.

To get 4% growth we need fixed capital investment of 25-30% of GNP. We presently only have 14% and falling. We do not have the capital to invest out of savings because capital flees the country to overseas. And what capital we do invest is mostly mal-investment.

Other emerging economies have not only internal savings but large foreign investment boosting fixed capital investment.

Nobody is rushing to invest here. The Mandela Rainbow nation fairytale is long over. The international perception is South Africa is a dangerous place to live, skilled people are leaving as fast as they can, corruption is endemic, black empowerment policies promote capital dilution and incompetent cadre deployment.

My spiritual application and strategy conclusions as follows:

The church in South Africa has been largely ineffective in any way producing the kind of righteous nation that follows the ways of the Lord to the extent that we can demonstrate that we are a blessed nation of the Lord.

We are not. We are under judgment. Because God judges the nations.

The Christian evangelical church is under the theological impression that one day in the future God will bring judgement on nations in The Great Tribulation and then one day in the future after "end time judgement" Jesus will come to establish His Kingdom and heal the nations. Until then there is

nothing we can actually do to disciple a nation into the ways of the Lord. That would be the dreaded "Dominionism" heresy.

My revelation is this and it might sound controversial but I will give a few scriptures to support:

- 1) God is now in control and ownership of all the earth and all nations. As such he holds all nations and rulers now responsible for how the rule and he holds all nations now responsible for their policies and actions.
- 2) The church has the responsibility both to save souls and teach people how to walk in the ways of the Lord and the church also has a prophetic and teaching role to the nation as to how it must rule according to the ways of the Lord.
- 3) In scripture the pattern of God's commands and judgments show that nations are given time. Either they repent and change or their "cup of iniquity fills" until God ends their time allotment.
- 4) Think of Job and Ninevah. Jonah declared 40 days and you will be destroyed. This is not unique. Read Isaiah the prophet and see how many nations God has a word of judgment for:

The book of Isaiah contains several chapters—especially chapters 13–23—that focus on oracles or "burdens" against various nations and cities. Isaiah explicitly names and addresses specific nations by their names in these passages. The main nations and regions named by Isaiah are:

- **Babylon** (Isaiah 13:1–14:23)
- **Assyria** (Isaiah 14:24–27; also referenced elsewhere)
- **Philistia** (Isaiah 14:28–32)
- **Moab** (Isaiah 15:1–16:14)
- **Syria (Damascus) and Israel (Ephraim)** (Isaiah 17:1–14; addressed together due to their alliance)
- Ethiopia (Cush) (Isaiah 18:1–7)
- **Egypt** (Isaiah 19:1–25)
- **Elam and Media** (Isaiah 21:2–10; not always as full nations, but as peoples involved in Babylon's fall)
- **Dumah (Edom)** (Isaiah 21:11–12)
- **Arabia** (Isaiah 21:13–17)
- **Tyre** (city-state, sometimes considered a nation in its own right; Isaiah 23:1–18)
- 5) Am I wrong in supposing that God today is the governor of the nations and still holds them accountable as He did in ages past? What does scripture say?

Numerous scriptures throughout the Old and New Testaments affirm God's sovereignty over the kingdoms and nations of the world. Here are some of the most significant:

Psalm 22:28 "For the kingdom is the LORD's: and he is the governor among the nations."

Daniel 2:20-21

Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, to whom belong wisdom and might. He changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding.

This passage explicitly states that God orchestrates the rise and fall of earthly rulers and kingdoms

Daniel 4:35

All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, and he does according to his will among the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of the earth; and none can stay his hand or say to him, "What have you done?"

Psalm 103:19

The Lord has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

Psalm 135:5-6

For I know that the Lord is great, and that our Lord is above all gods. Whatever the Lord pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps.

Isaiah 46:9-10

Remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, "My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose."

Job 12:23

He makes nations great, and he destroys them; he enlarges nations, and leads them away.

Acts 17:26

And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place."

Here, in the New Testament affirms that God has set both the times and the geographical boundaries for all nations. It still applies to 2025!

6) If Jesus is the same yesterday today and forever.....what makes you think that since all power in heaven and on earth has been given unto him- what do you think He is saying about South Africa, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Zambia, Mozambique?

Here is what I believe is South Africa's near future in the plan of God and is now visible from all political and economic signs.

I believe that like Ninevah and other nations of prophecy in scripture God has allowed the cup of iniquity that is South Africa today to fill up. We are under judgement. Not 40 days until Ninevah falls but 40 years until this wickedness overwhelming this nation causes its collapse from its own induced corruption, violence and lawlessness. There is no blessing over this nation.

And yet Southern Africa is our Promised Land. But to carry the Biblical narrative a bit further...when God told Abraham leave your place and go I will show you your promised land. When he arrived there he could not settle because of a great drought. He had to go Egypt to restore his fortunes.

When Israel came out of Egypt they could only take their promised land Canaan when the iniquity of the Canaanites had reached such proportions that the Lord could then take the land away from them and give it Israel

When the fall of Southern Africa has reached its time from its endemic corruption and lawlessness then the Church must be ready to heal the land and possess it for the Kingdom of God.

We need to be ready like Daniel when he was given the Prime Minister role of the Persian Empire, like Ezra and Nehemiah were ready to teach the law of the Lord to the New Jerusalem they built for the returning band of Israelites out of Babylon.

Until then many will leave the land like the Israelites who were led into Egypt or led into Babylon until the Lord was ready to return them to their Promised Land with skills and assets to rebuild the land.

Expect many more to leave South Africa as the economic collapse proceeds. But remember America, UK, Canada, New Zealand, Australia are not our promised land. There will be a time of miraculous return.

For those of us left behind to spread the Kingdom teaching Isaiah 26:20-21 applies...

Come my people enter thou into thy chambers and shut thy doors about thee; hide thyself as it is for a little moment until the indignation be past. For behold the Lord cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity, the earth also shall disclose her blood and shall no more cover her slain
