## Issues in Transition to Kingdom World Government

I want to give you some analysis of world power dynamics so we can understand our path as a church towards God's goal of handing the Kingdom to the saints. There are important things happening in America, Russia, China, the EU, Israel and the Catholic Church that need analysis...but lets start with some economic analysis.

My governing paradigm here at Kingdom Vision is the radical concept of a transition in world power from the nations and rulers of this world system to the Kingdom of God administered through the saints of the Most High as Daniel 7:21 declares.

It is important to imprint this fact in your spirit so I am going to repeat 4 fundamental statements of scripture:

1) Psalm 115;116 "***The heavens and the heavens are the Lord's but the earth has he given to the sons of men***". Which is why Jesus had to come as a man to redeem mankind and restore the image of God in man so we can rule God's earthly property according to His Kingdom principles.

2) Daniel 7:21 "***And the time came that the saints possessed the Kingdom...***"  
The ruling authority of this world and all dominions of future human expansion into a trillion galaxies are to be under the authority of God's people...which is why Jesus said "fear not little flock it is the father's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom."

3) The nations of the earth will eventually run out of answers to the governance problems of the earth and turn to the saints of the Kingdom of God for solutions. Micah 4.

4) The result will be that the glory of the Lord will cover the earth as the waters cover the seas and men will not learn war any more and nations will be discipled into the Kingdom of God. (Habakkuk 2;14, Isaiah 2)

The issues to watch during this transition:

- God is preparing His people to take responsibility for the administration of planet earth. There is coming "new wineskins" in a second reformation that will be able to contain the extra power from God for the extra responsibilities.
- There are enormous technological advances now being released by God as helps for us in order to heal the earth and restructure world economies to achieve His Kingdom purposes, which also include: healing sickness and disease, ending world poverty, homelessness, universal education, spreading the knowledge of the Lord to all people, creating conditions for the endless growth of the Kingdom of God.
- There are failing ideologies and forms of economy and political structures that have outlived their usefulness and can no longer be considered answers to the problems ahead.

- There are enormous disruptions coming in world affairs as the world goes through this transition period. That is why you keep hearing about "the end times" in church preaching. The problem of course is that they are not yet aware of what is ending and what is coming.

So let me give you some quick analysis of important world power structures that are in transition. Lets look at the economic situation to start this week...

### **World Economic Models**

You will have noticed in the media the rising trade war between east and west, New sanctions, tariffs, trade barriers etc. What is happening here?

There is a terrible fear and realization in the west that China and Russia have probably found an economic model that the west cannot compete against. Here is the issue...

In a mere 30 years the greatest economic miracle has occurred in human history: China has managed to bring 600 million people out of abject poverty. They ended national hunger, illiteracy, joblessness...they moved hundreds of millions of people from rural poverty to urban cities and national full employment. In fact they went on such an enormous construction spree that there are entire "ghost cities" that are ready to take millions of inhabitants but there are not enough people in China to fill all the new cities they created. China now has an employment crisis for its 1,3 billion people...not enough workers to fill all the jobs. So they are in a major push into Africa and SE Asia to set up factories overseas to find workers there to produce products.

Russia is in a similar position except they took a mere 20 years to go from the utter economic devastation of the 1990's under that drunken fool Boris Yeltsin and his American economic advisors. When Putin took over he radically altered the Russian economic model to follow China. The economic model that Russia has followed under Putin has also brought the Russian people out of poverty. A sign of this: last year Russia became the largest exporter of wheat in the world...they earn more from food exports than from military exports.

And what is the difference between east and west?

The Chinese and Russians are following a doctrine of state capitalism...the west is under a system of corporate capitalism.

There are important lessons for us as a church to learn here as we need to define an economic model for the Kingdom of God and its application to the world economy of tomorrow.

Under state capitalism the Chinese and Russian state takes control of the allocation of capital in the economy and directs it towards the areas of national priorities.

Under corporate capitalism the corporations of the world control the flow of financial capital and apply it to what the corporations deem to be the priorities.

In China the government controls the major banks and directs them where to apply loans in the economy. So enormous amount of finance was directed by the state to build entire new cities to house the influx of people from the rural areas. Capital was provided for massive construction of transport systems, power generation, and finance for new capital equipment for factories.

The result was the massive infrastructure spending to modernize the nation and to retool industry to greatly increase productivity of labour. This went with a great increase in schooling and technology investment to produce engineers, doctors, scientists and technicians.

In America the banking system over the last 20 years also created trillions of dollars in new finance. In fact some 17 trillion dollars in new money in the form of credit expansion into the national economy. Where did those trillions go? They went to the corporate elite who created vast new pools of debt instruments for mortgages, real estate booms, corporate share buybacks that boosted stock exchange values by the trillions....a veritable financial casino of money speculation in stocks, debt and the financialization of the economy.

Those trillions of new dollars then found their way to the east to provide purchasing power for China to produce the goods that America wanted but were no longer producing. America's national infrastructure is starved of capital, so are its factories.

Here is the essence of the problem that American Christians will have to confront: They expect Donald Trump to "drain the swamp". He is not going to be able to do it. The essence of the swamp is this: Their founding document....the Declaration of Independence created the American DNA...we the people have a right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.

That sounds fine. Except that in 1871 by Congressional law and approved by the US Supreme Court....another "people" was added to the list of "we the people". That "people" was the concept of the corporation. Companies were declared to be legal "people" with all the rights of natural people. These new "people" then start a war on the human people. They took on themselves the right to create the money and credit of the nation (the 1913 Federal Reserve Act). They took on themselves the right to lower taxes and tax exemptions for themselves and not available to human people. They started a process of accumulating the property assets of the nation by giving themselves access to the credit of the nation and the savings of the people. They took control of the people's government. They legislated for their own benefit. They turned the people into wage slaves, peasants in the new feudal order.

Watch to see if Donald Trump can get anything from the financial powers in America for his "infrastructure" program to rebuild America's crumbling infrastructure? No chance. In America the Central Bank will create trillions in new credit to bail out their banks....but they will not create trillions at no interest for America to rebuild the nations infrastructure or to retool their factories. Corporations can get a better financial return on that new capital by buying up foreign assets.

So I predict Trump will fail and I predict the Democrats will take control in America and that will be radical democrats as in "power to the people" of free education, free, health care, free this, free that... Democracy too will fail like it did in ancient Athens.

Here in South Africa we are going through a similar economic failure and we Christians need to get ready with answers for the future.

Here is our transition lesson for this week.

We the people of God are going to have to work out with the guidance of the Word of God, the inspiration of the Holy Spirit a new economic model for the future healing of the nations. There are already lessons we can learn from what is working and not working in the world.

Here are some indications:

We need to get control of our finances. Our savings are the result of our own hard work and represent real work we have done to create wealth in the economy. The difference in what we produce to what we consume represent our savings.

We place our savings in the bank and then that gives it over to others to use those savings for what? Most of those savings go to debt creation for consumption and the rest goes to corporate expansion.

We are going to have to come up with a means by which our savings are utilized for productive investment that goes into productivity, infrastructure and job creation. The new technology tools that are coming out will allow us to do this. I cannot in this blog elaborate those answers.

We have to be prepared for the fact that governments have always destroyed currencies by excessive money printing and excessive debt creation. We need to prepare for a future of our own e-currency and banking. Again the technology is available with forerunners now coming out like Bitcoin and blockchain technology. Again I cannot here elaborate but this issue must come onto the Kingdom economic agenda.

We have to start our own production and consumer cycles by connecting our Kingdom producers directly in contact with Kingdom consumers. Again the technology is now available for that. Think of what our own Amazon, Facebook, Uber etc and the Internet can do for us here.

We have to raise our own capital and investment into our own investment vehicles to direct our savings for Kingdom purposes. Think here again of "crowd funding" through the internet and using block chain technology for distributed share ledgers for ownership shares in Kingdom companies.

We have to get our people technically trained for the future. Government schooling is increasingly a waste of time and money. Again the power of the internet and the new virtual reality headsets will revolutionize education making it cheap and accessible to the masses.

We have to look at local production instead of international production. 3d printing and local production of high density and cheap energy means we can get off the national expensive electric grids and create local productive communities.

The Chinese and Russian economic models tell us that we as Christians need to find a model whereby we as a national Christian community work together to mobilize our economic productive economic potential according to an agenda that furthers the economic program of God on earth, while at the same time we encourage local entrepreneurs to create new and exciting products and services that energize our local communities with new job opportunities and create prosperity for our people.

We have to prepare now for the inevitable collapse of non-working world economic models and start the exodus to a new economic order under God's Kingdom economy.

That also means rejected the usual nonsense that is being preached in our pulpits about prosperity. It is time preachers allow those in the pews whom God has called to the economy to devise the Kingdom economy.
