Corporate Capitalism and the Death of Nations

The transition of the Church to the ministry of healing the nations starts by recognizing that nations are dying and honesty about one of the major causes of the death of nations....no children caused by Corporate Capitalism.

Last week I introduced the idea to you of "Corporate Capitalism" as a danger to the world. The central idea here is that under law in all countries in the world introduced in recent history is the legal definition of the "Corporation" as a "person" under law. And most of us work for this "person". But this person not only has all the rights of a human person in law but has accumulated legal and financial rights not enjoyed by humans for the purpose of maximizing its ability to acquire the assets of the world at exponential rates.

Now here is my scriptural insight to the spiritual curse upon the nations that is causing them to die...and I will show you below how they are dying. Read the whole of the 28th chapter of Deuteronomy. It is applicable not just to the nation of Israel, it is God's message to all the nations of the world that we the Church need to proclaim. Which is quite simple and to the point....there are blessings and curses from God depending on whether you keep the laws of God or whether you rebel against the Lord God.

Here is the pertinent curse that I associate with the corporations of the earth....

Deut. 28:43 *"The stranger that is within thee shall get up above thee very high and thou shall come very low. He shall lend to thee and thou shall not lend to him. He shall be the head and you shall be the tail."*

What scripture makes clear is that there are visible economic consequences to people and nations that refuse to live the laws of God. Debt slavery is explicitly promised by the Lord...debt slavery and dominion over your life by "the stranger". Now if you look at the list of curses there it goes on to describe the destruction of the family and the loss of assets and wealth to the "stranger" to the point where you just become a wage slave.

As we look upon the international world scene we are actually fooled by appearances. On the one hand we look at enormous shopping malls, an exploding abundance of goods and services, an apparent world of unprecedented prosperity, a vision of a technocratic future of endless possibilities. Mankind has never had it so good....

And on the positive side this seems to be the case....but lets look a bit closer to the reality behind the endless growth vision of the corporate world fantasy and see what the future reality is now unfolding. And what is now silently happening is an economic virus that will destroy the nations of the earth infected by it....and people are gladly participating in their national destruction.

Here is the first reality that you need to confront. This was the headline from an article in the Guardian newspaper last week:

The Richest 1% Will Own Two-Thirds Of Global Wealth By 2030, Report Finds

This is what the article goes on to say....

Back in November Credit Suisse highlighted an alarming - yet altogether unsurprising - milestone in the increasing concentration of global wealth that has been perhaps the most influential force behind the populist revolts that rocked the US in 2016 and have continued to unfurl across Europe. According to the Swiss bank's annual "global wealth pyramid," for the first time, the wealthiest 1% of the world's population had accumulated more than half of its aggregate household wealth.

But while CS's report was unequivocally dire, a recent report published by the UK Parliament is even more harrowing.

According to [projections produced by the House of Commons library](#) suggest that the top 1% of the world's wealthiest individuals will own roughly 64% of the planet's wealth by 2030.

An alarming projection produced by the House of Commons library suggests that if trends seen since the 2008 financial crash were to continue, then the top 1% will hold 64% of the world's wealth by 2030

This extreme concentration of the wealth of the world in a very few hands is causing extreme levels of desperate economic privation for ordinary working people. The surplus income of invested wealth is flowing in abundance to the few at the top...starving the mass of humanity at the bottom of a living wage...or at least a wage that can support a family.


And what is the result? Here is a quote from a report on the demographic implosion that is hitting Europe...a future of no children:

As couples grapple with a longer-than-expected stretch of low growth, high unemployment, precarious jobs and financial strain, they are increasingly deciding to have just one child — or none.


Approximately a fifth of women born in the 1970s are [likely to remain childless](#) in Greece, Spain and Italy, a level not seen since World War I, according to the Wittgenstein Center for Demography and Global Human Capital, based in Vienna. Birthrates in the region have slid back almost to where they were before the crisis emerged in 2008. Women in Spain had been averaging 1.47 children per

household, up from 1.24 in 2000. But those gains have all but evaporated. In Italy, Portugal and Greece, birthrates have reverted to about 1.3.

The one cause of childlessness is economic poverty. The other cause of childlessness is economic prosperity. That is the problem is Germany, Korea, Japan, America and China. Look at this graph for the future of Germany:



This is the future of China...



By 2030 China will have 100 million fewer working age population than in 2018. In Korea women are having an average of 1 child in their lifetime. At current trends of depopulation in Japan there will only be 300 Japanese left in 300 years time....but long before that in the very near future Japan like most of Europe and other rich countries....their economies will collapse.

What is happening in the rich countries" Why no children? I understand poor countries why woman cannot afford children.

Here is the truth...many woman are choosing corporate careers over family and children. In America and other nations abortions are in the millions per year because children are an inconvenience to a life in pursuit of money, pleasure and career advancement. And then you get the bizarre statistics from young people in places like Japan and Korea where sex between young people is at an all time low because a life of virtual reality playing games and watching pornography is preferred to the burdens of a real human relationship.

Economic prosperity is destroying family life as people prefer careers and a life of self indulgent pleasure seeking....and economic hardship is destroying family life as young people just cannot afford to raise a family on low working wages.

Here are the economic realities the church needs to face:

- The nations of the world are in a demographic time bomb from which there is now no way out...they are dying.
- There are not enough workers for the future to be both producers and consumers and taxpayers to keep the corporate economic system going.
- The combination of rising rates of over 60 year olds that need to be taken care of and mountains of accumulating debt of nations that need to be paid for by future generations all depends on more and more young people entering the world labour force to care for the elderly and pay for the future taxes and debt....those young people are not there...they have not been born and there are fewer and fewer wombs every year to produce those children regardless of how much incentives government try to give to form families and encourage children.
- The corporate "stranger" in our midst is going to try to solve this problem with artificial workers called robots with artificial intelligence. That is their technocratic future...artificial persons (corporations) running the world with artificial intelligence and artificial workers.
- This fantasy of the future will fall on the rock of reality. The entire corporate world falls apart if there are no customers, no consumers. You cannot have endless corporate growth built on endless debt creation when there are no children in the future.
- Corporate artificial persons have created an artificial reality of supposed prosperity but as you look closer that world model is destroying the future by creating a world of no children.

The church needs to wake up this reality. This is not a future World War 3 of Armageddon and Gog and Magog and nuclear destruction. This is the here and now of economic destruction that is wiping out hundreds of millions of children as sure as a Bubonic plague or nuclear bomb on a city...this demographic bomb is now exploding and every year that passes ensures that the inevitable future is a world economic collapse and the death of nations.

What do we do?

That is what this series of transition to a new world is all about. God promised Abraham a blessing....children like the stars of the heavens and the sand of the seas. God promised Jacob companies of nations will come from him.

God and His covenant with us as the seed of Abraham is about children and families and new nations and economic blessings that will ensure the endless growth of His Kingdom.

What we need to do firstly is to admit that regardless of all the talk and preaching about prosperity, our church families are suffering just like the rest of the world. We are tied into a failing world economic system that is destroying our ability to raise and sustain our families.

This collapsing future is not going to be avoided by dreaming about the rapture or dead end theology of the antichrist taking over the world. All demographic and economic trends now before us show that between 2018 and 2030 the irreversible economic and demographic collapse will cause severe world political, ecological and economic debt collapse.

Our first task is going to be to replace "corporate capitalism" with 'God's community capitalism.' That entails that our production, savings, organizations, financial structures are taken out of the decision making control of the world corporate capital structures and brought under the Lordship of Jesus Christ. And that will result in us making family growth as our economic goals.

As we withdraw our labour and buying power from the world system and redirect it into the Kingdom structures we hasten the collapse of corporate capitalism. As the world increasingly depopulates and unbelievers amuse and abort themselves to death...we the families of God in the earth, blessed of God, grow and grow till the meek inherit the earth.

And then we put all those robots and artificial intelligences that the dying corporations made for themselves to work for us while we get on with developing our Kingdom communities, and all those empty cities that the Chinese government built, all those nice world sport stadiums standing empty for empty Olympics, and all those wonderful optic fibres connecting the world, and all those scientific breakthroughs and technologies that atheists developed (but who have no children to leave it to)....all these wonderful things will constitute the greatest wealth transfer in the history of the world as the Lord promised to take us to a Promised Land consisting of houses and cities we did not build, productive assets we did not plant....all built for us by unbelievers who decided having children and families are too much of a burden.
